1. Referral to CARES – Expression of Interest

2. Multi Agency Review to commence assessment paperwork

3. Referral to Prehab Support

4. Prehab Service facilitates visit to RR Providers, feeding back to CARES the individuals preferred choice.

5. Prehab and The Beacons assist with Entry in to Community Recovery

6. Multi Agency Review prior to entry in to Rehabilitation Service to agree entry date

7. Entry in to Rehabilitation Service – with referral to R2R

8. After 4 weeks – Multi Agency Review – If appropriate, 3rd sector (Reachout and The GIVIT) will disengage

9. R2R to assist with community integration – timescales for this will be discussed with the residential rehabilitation provider

10. Prior to return to community, a Multi Agency Review to be held to discuss re-integration in to the community focusing on whole support needs. i.e. Housing, recovery, care and treatment.

11. Discharge – R2R to provide support on day of discharge as well as ongoing support in the community

12. 2 weeks after discharge (Earlier if needed) Multi Agency Final review.
